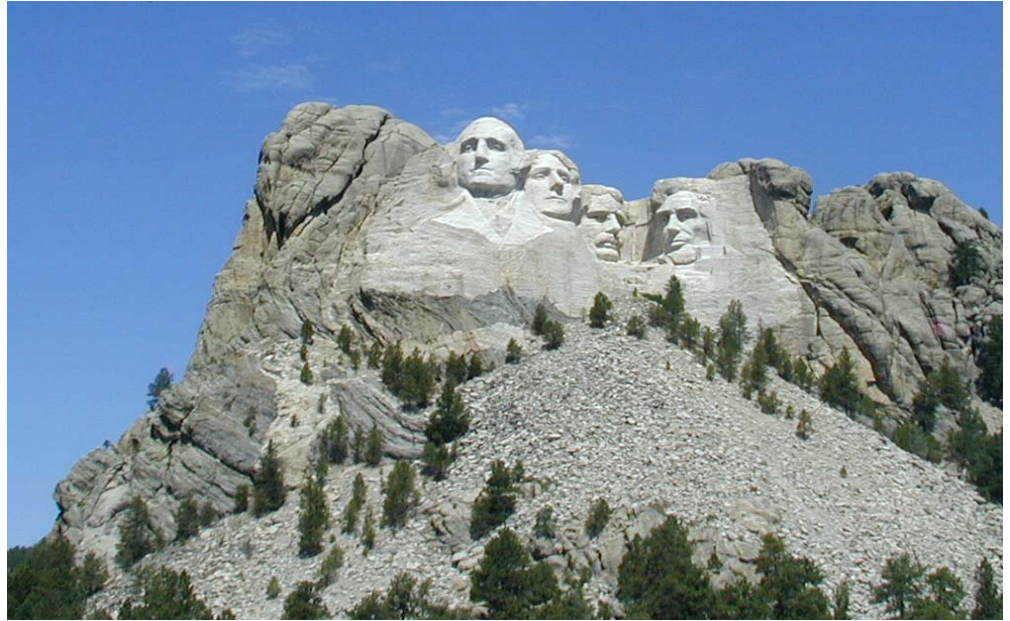

**Here's how your holiday

**Day One: Seattle to
Salt Lake City**

Our lovely holiday begins as we
pick you up from your Seattle area
home and take you to the Sea Tac
airport for your short flight to Salt

"This is the Place" Monument, and

to our lovely downtown hotel where

**Day Two: Salt Lake
to Jackson Hole**

Today we will motorcoach through
the states of Utah, Idaho and Wyo-
ming as we make our way to the
famous western town of Jackson
Hole. You will see the Great Salt
Lake, Logan Canyon, Bear Lake
and Snake River Canyon. In the
late afternoon you will check into
your mountainside resort.

Day Three: Jackson Hole to Yellowstone

The morning is free to do as you wish. You may want to ship in town or even take a river float trip. This afternoon we will drive to nearby Grand Tetons National



Park. We will follow the Snake River past majestic 13,000 foot peaks with stops at Menor Ferry, the Church of the Continental Divide and the renowned Jackson Lake Lodge. We will then drive the Rockefeller Parkway to Yellowstone, the country's first National Park and considered by many to be the finest. You will enjoy two nights hotel accommodations right inside the park.

Day Four: Yellowstone National Park

Today you'll witness nature as it rebuilds itself amidst the varied scenic wonders of Yellowstone.



Travel over the Continental Divide, stop at famous Old Faithful Lodge and thrill to the sight of the legendary geyser. View the Fountain Paint Pots, majestic Hayden Valley and the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone River. After a day of sightseeing, we'll head back to the



hotel where you will enjoy a lovely dinner with your traveling companions.

Day Five: Yellowstone to Sheridan

After breakfast you will enjoy a scenic drive to Cody, the center of Wyoming's "Cowboy Country". Visit the Buffalo Bill Historic Museum, considered to have the best western collection in the world. See world-class exhibits featuring pioneer life & Indian/Western artwork. Continue on through Shell Falls Canyon and onto scenic Granite Pass, located in the Bighorn Mountains. From there you will head to Sheridan, site of the infamous 1860's Sioux Indian Wars and now home to large cattle ranches.

Day Six: Sheridan/Custer's Last Stand Battlefield/ Rapid City

Travel into Montana this morning to the famous Little Big Horn Battlefield. You will retrace the paths of George Armstrong Custer, his 7th Cavalry and Sitting Bull as you tour this fascinating national monument-home of "Custer's Last Stand." Then you'll return to Wyoming, cross over the Bighorn Mountains at scenic Granite Pass and arrive in the Black Hills of South Dakota. We'll make a stop in Deadwood, the historic mining town where Wild Bill Hickok was shot. You'll then enjoy a two night stay in Rapid City, where you will enjoy a night illumination tour of Mt. Rushmore after dinner.

Day Seven: Mt. Rushmore & Black Hills Crazy Horse Memorial

Today is an action packed day. You will visit the Rushmore-Borglum Story to learn the Gutzen Borglum's 14 year dedication to sculpting this monument. Then we are off to view awesome Mt. Rushmore in the daylight and marvel at



next stop is at historic 1849 Fort Laramie, a restored western outpost & home to army Indian fighters. Travel across the wide-open prairie to Cheyenne, famous for its "Frontier Days" rodeo. Tonight you will check into your hotel where you will enjoy a farewell dinner with your traveling companions.

Day Nine: Cheyenne/ Denver/Seattle

After breakfast we will drive to Colorado, the mile-high city of Denver. You'll enjoy a city tour with Larimer Square, the State Capitol Building and Coors Field. You will then head to the Denver International Airport for your short flight back to Seattle. Upon our arrival, our airport shuttle will return you back to your Seattle area home. Welcome Home!
