Day 4-Narrated tour of Sedona-Leisure time in Sedona!

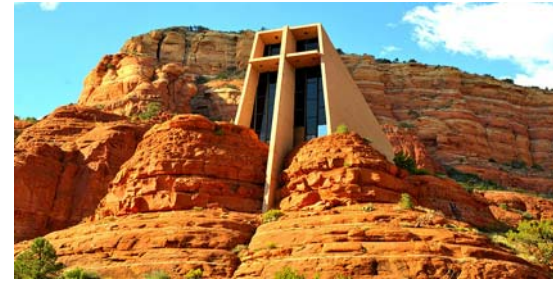
