DAY 4: LA FORTUNA-MONTEVERDE

You won't believe your eyes as you travel into the Monteverde Cloud Forest, where trees grow to heights of 100 feet! In this spectacular ecosystem, you will encounter many incredible species of flora and fauna.

Then you continue on to Selvatura Park, a cloud forest preserve in the heart of Monteverde. Journey



over suspension bridges learning about some of the region's most



beautiful forests. Visit butterfly gardens and a hummingbird gallery containing more than 14 different species.

DAY 5: MONTEVERDE

A morning nature walk allows you to discover the natural beauty of the cloud forest first hand. This forest is the home of the world's largest population of the endangered quetzal, celebrated for its gorgeous jewel-toned plumage. It is an elusive bird but keep your eyes peeled and you may get lucky!

DAY 6: LA FORTUNA-JACO-QUEPOS

In the morning after breakfast we'll do a scenic drive to Jaco. We'll continue on to

Quepos, most famous for its fabulous fishing, white sandy beaches, and beautiful mountain outcroppings jutting into the crystal clear waters of Manuel Antonio National Park. **Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner**



DAY 7: VISIT TO MANUEL ANTONIO NATIONAL PARK

Today we'll visit the Manuel Antonio National Park. It is the country's smallest national park at just over 683 hectares, but it is also one of its most amazing. Home to one of the last sizable populations of the endangered Squirrel Monkey in the region, White Faced and Howler monkeys are also common in the park. Cathedral Point with its forest topped cliffs is connected to the mainland by a thin land bridge that separates the parks two most popular beaches, Playa Espadilla Sur and Playa Manuel Antonio. Playa Manuel Antonio is one of the most beautiful beaches in Costa Rica and has been rated one of the top ten in the world. The beach is a half mile long, perfect white sand crescent bordered by deep green mangroves and palms. The park abounds with wildlife and in a days



visit it is possible to see iguanas, monkeys, sloths agoutis, paccaries armadillos, pisotes, coatimundis and raccoons.

Enjoy a morning at leisure before we head back to San Jose.
