Day Ten: Cruising– Heraklion-Crete

Heraklion, the capital of Crete and its principal commercial port is just three miles away from the fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos.



Discovered in 1899 by Sir Arthur Evans and partially reconstructed, the elaborate Palace is believed to be the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos and the seat of ancient Minoan culture. The Archaeological Museum in Heraklion dis-



plays many of the treasures found during the excavations.

Day Eleven: Kusadasi, Turkey

Visit the Turkish port of Kusadasi for an excursion to the Ephesus Archaeological Site, the



former capital of the Roman province of Asia. Walk in the footsteps of Apostle Paul, who lived and preached here, and meditate on what life must have been like for the early Ephesian Christians in this pagan society. Also, see the House of Mary, where the Virgin Mary is said



to have spent her last days. Continue your cruise to the island of Patmos, the “Jerusalem of the Aegean,” and visit the Monastery of St. John and the Cave of the Apocalypse, where



John the Evangelist received the visions that he recorded in the Book of the Revelation during his exile.
