### Day Four: Ferry To Ocracoke Island

At Cedar Island, ferry across the Pamlico Sound to colorful Ocracoke Island. The town has the feel of a New England village, but with a semi-tropical air! Settle in, and then partake in an afternoon historic tour. Hear about the island's pirate and WWII history, harrowing hurricanes, and shipwrecks. This evening, enjoy a delicious seafood dinner (the town is famous for its crab cakes and Hatteras clam chowder).



## Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

### Day Five: Ocracoke Island To Nags Head

Take the short ferry to Hatteras and coach past Buxton Woods, a forest of oaks, beeches, and palmettos. Towering above the dunes is candy-striped Cape Hatteras



Lighthouse, tallest brick lighthouse in the country. Cross over to Roanoke Island for a visit to Fort Raleigh, home of the first English settlement in the New World. This was

the town founded by Sir Walter

Raleigh, pre-dating both Jamestown and Plymouth.

Then, explore the Wright Brothers National Memorial in



Kill Devil Hills, the site of their first powered flight in 1903. Arrive at your beachfront hotel in Nags Head for two nights.

## Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

### Day Six: Day Trip to Corolla / Wild Horse Safari

This morning, head north up the narrow strand to the historic town of Corolla. Tour Whalehead Club, a beautifully



restored 1920s Art Nouveau style residence and also see the Currituck Beach Lighthouse. Embark on an off-road nature safari in specially designed vehicles as we search for wild horses, sea birds and foxes along the shore. Return to your hotel and relax prior to your Farewell Dinner at a fine local restaurant.

### Day Seven: Nags Head To Norfolk / Fly Home

Coach north to Norfolk, the largest US Naval Base and home to the Atlantic fleet. Visit the General Douglas MacArthur Memorial & Tomb. Later, explore Nauticus, a maritime-themed museum located on the downtown waterfront. Then arrive at the airport for your return flights home.
