## DAY 4: Charleston to Savannah

## DAY 5: Savannah Sightseeing

The Cotton Trade made this city a vital shipping port during the 1800's and today her unique past has been preserved. Drive by the Old Cotton Exchange, River Street, & Madison Square of General Sherman's 'March to the Sea' fame. You'll also tour a restored antebellum mansion prior to a free afternoon to see the sights of John Berendt's "Midnight in the Garden of Good & Evil" or stroll the cobblestone streets at your leisure.

## DAY 6: Savannah to Jekyll Isle

Depart Savannah for St Simon's Island where you'll enjoy guided tour of the Island viewing the famous Christ Church. ## DAY 8: Jacksonville to Seattle
