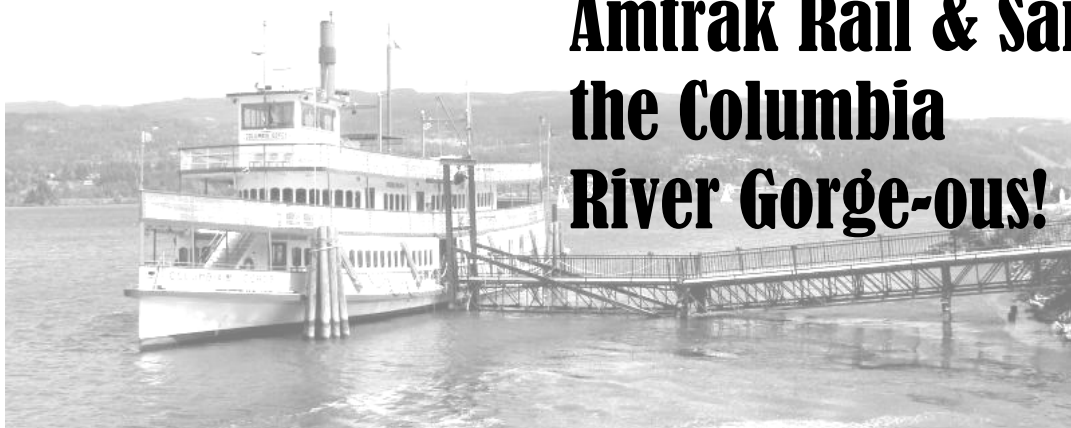

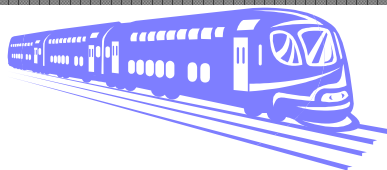

Here's How Your Trip Will Unfold....

April 14th, 2010 Portland-Rail through the Gorge-Dalles

All aboard our motorcoach for a trip to
Portland. See the highlights of the city
including Old Town, China Town, a Classical
Chinese Garden and the International Rose
Test Gardens. This afternoon, we will board
the Empire Builder for a scenic rail journey
through the Columbia Gorge to the Dalles. Sit
back relax and enjoy as we travel the
Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area.
Pass Beacon Rock a basaltic formation said to
be second in size to Gibraltar. On the Oregon
side of the river, several waterfalls are visible.
The highest waterfall, Multnomah Falls,
cascades 620 feet to the Columbia River. Next,
Bonneville Dam More than a half mile from
end to end, this dam is one of the
government's greatest power and navigation
projects. Finally we'll disembark in the
Dalles. Lewis and Clark visited this area,
named for an ancient village where Native
Americans gathered to trade for salmon.
Overnight in the Dalles.

April 15th, 2010 Dalles-Columbia River Paddlewheel Cruise- Seattle

After breakfast, we'll head to Cascade Locks
to board an Old Fashioned Paddle wheeler for
a luncheon cruise. The Captain narrates some
of the history and lore of the Columbia River
and Gorge while you sightsee and enjoy a
beautiful lunch. After, head north to Seattle.
