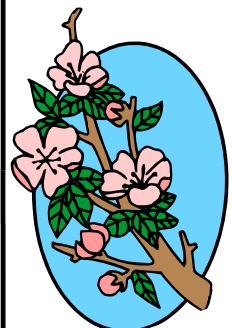

Today, we'll journey through history as we tour Mt. Vernon, home to George Washington, his estate gardens, museum and final resting place. Later today, we'll stop for a photo of the White House followed by a visit to Ford's Theater where Abraham Lincoln was fatally shot by John Wilkes Booth.
